*The wine is fleshy, ripe and finishes with impressive forest floor sweetness, rounded out by peppery tannins. Think crème de cassis, cherries, and a lovely note of liquorice on the palate, mixed with pepper and Asian spices.*

*Elegant and concentrated, dark red fruit with black plum and damson on the nose. Spice and herb notes coming through on the finish.*

*Deep ruby in colour, the wine develops a beautiful complexity on the nose revealing aromas of black cherry and blackcurrant with a toasted background and accents of blond tobacco.*

*This wine is very aromatic and juicy with rich red fruit aromas. The tannins are beautifully integrated to add a sensation of tension. The use of both old and new oak adds a spicy complexity to the palate.*

*Dark creamy bramble, classic vanilla, coffee bean, toasty vanilla swipe.*

*Juicy red cherry, strawberry and raspberry core, velvety texture.*

*A well structured, complex wine with intensity, persistence and character. Super ripe black fruits, soft vanilla, warming spice and bags of freshness and tannin.*

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Barolo, Casali del Barone, Piedmont, Italy, 2018 £78.00

*Rich and complex with aromas of eucalyptus, tobacco, and leather. The wine has had long aging in both cask and bottle to develop beautiful complexities typical of good Barolo.*

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Brunello di Montalcino, Biondi-Santi, Tuscany, Italy, 2017 £400.00

*This wine has an intense ruby red colour. It opens with a graceful nose focusing on citrus peel with nuances of withered rose, spice and fresh red fruits. Balanced and delicate, on the palate, it delights with cherry flavours and red berry notes. Structured tannins and depth continue through to a long finish.*

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Rioja Reserva 'Gran Bohedal' Bodegas Bohedal 2018 £55.00

*Dark plum fruit, cassis, tobacco and liquorice spice notes on the velvety finish*

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Crianza, Pesquera, Ribera del Duero, Spain, 2016 £76.00

*Red fruit such as strawberries is perceived. Wood very well integrated with those vanilla, roasted and balsamic notes*

### PORTUGUAL

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Cota 700, Carlos Lucas Vinhos, Dão, Portugal, 2021 £38.00

*Red, almost violet colour, with the perfumes of black mulberry and blackberries and a light nuance of pine needles. The wine is very fresh, young with a sweet but elegant palate.*

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'Gradual', Quinta da Costa do Pinhão, Douro, Portugal, 2020 £62.00

*Fresh red fruit and plum aromas typical of the region. Hints of spice, black pepper and cloves as well as some balsamic.*

*Distinctive Barossa Shiraz showcasing classing ripe dark black fruit and signature cracked black pepper spice.* £46.00

Grenache Shiraz Mataro 'Cuvée Juveniles' Torbreck, Barossa, Australia, 2019

*A fresh, mid palate with a vivacity and energy that this blend always generates. Ripe, juicy flavours of blackberry and cassis, spiced cherries, minerals and succulent blueberry fruit all balanced with fresh acidity and a fine gentle tannin structure.* £62.00
